- Sarah (not her real name), a young woman living with a physical disability, had dropped out of school and depended entirely on her family for survival. Through TAF's vocational skills program, she was trained in tailoring.

Today, she owns a tailoring shop where she trains other people at a cost, she earns her own income, supports her basic needs, and has regained confidence. She is now seen as a role model in her community.

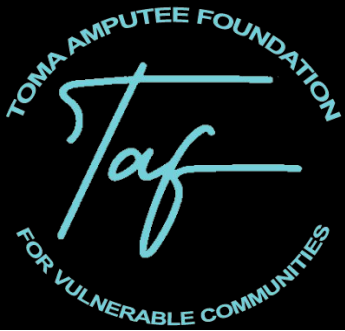

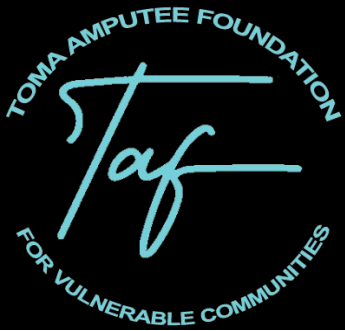

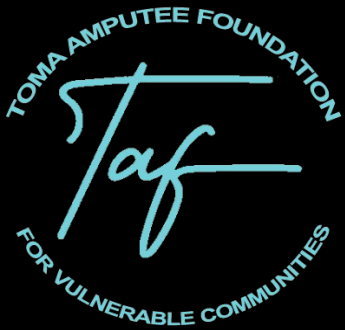
